Decisions on these Awards will be made by November 1st yearly, and recipients will be notified via email if they are Award recipients. Presentation of these Awards will occur yearly at the RCCSS(C) Annual General Meeting in November.

NOMINATION GUIDELINES:

- Nominators should utilize the attached nomination form

REVIEW PROCESS:

- The “**FOUNDATION**” will assign an individual, who is judged by the “**FOUNDATION**” to have no conflict of interest pertaining to the Award, to referee the blinded peer review process
- All nominations will undergo a double blinded peer review and will be reviewed by a selection committee that will consist of a minimum of 2 “**FOUNDATION**” members as reviewers and 1 non-“**FOUNDATION**” reviewer, and there will always be a majority of “**FOUNDATION**” members on the selection committee
 - Nomination forms will be removed of any identifying information
 - Nominators and nominees will be blinded to the reviewers
- A total summative score using a standardized scoring rubric by reviewers will determine who will win the Awards
