ANNOUNCEMENT:

THE FOUNDATION for the Royal College of Chiropractic Sports Sciences (Canada) (herein referred to as the “**FOUNDATION**”) is proud to announce a call for submissions for their Annual Research Funding Grants. These Grants are open to chiropractors and scientific researchers wishing to conduct sports-focused research, where at least one member of the authorship team is a Canadian Sports Fellow, Sports Sciences Resident, or Member of the Royal College of Chiropractic Sports Sciences (Canada).

Decisions on this/these Grant(s) will be made by October 1st yearly, and applicants will be notified via email of the result of their application. Presentation of this/these Grant(s) will occur yearly at the RCCSS(C) Annual General Meeting in November.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES:

- Qualified submissions include original research projects, systematic reviews and scoping reviews that are proposed, ongoing, or recently completed but not yet submitted for publication
- Submissions must utilize the [Application Form \(here\)](#) which will include:
 - Abstract
 - Introduction & Methods
 - Any preliminary pilot work (if available)
 - Implications of your work to sports health care
 - Budget that includes an outline of the use of funds
 - Intent for knowledge dissemination

REVIEW PROCESS:

- The “**FOUNDATION**” will assign an individual, who is judged by the “**FOUNDATION**” to have no conflict of interest pertaining to the Grant, to oversee the blinded peer review process. (i.e., the individual has not directly or indirectly applied for and is not directly supervising a student/resident applying for a grant for the current grant cycle)
- All submissions will undergo a double blinded peer review and will be reviewed by a selection committee that will consist of a minimum of 3 reviewers
 - Submissions will be removed of any identifying information
 - Applicants will be blinded to the reviewers
- Peer reviewers will not include anyone who has directly or indirectly applied for this Grant for the current grant cycle, and any individuals who are seeking grants for the current grant cycle will be removed entirely from participating in the review process
- A total summative score using a standardized scoring rubric will be used by reviewers to determine who will win the Grant(s)

STIPULATIONS OF THE RESEARCH FUNDING GRANTS:

- At least one member of the authorship team must be a Canadian Sports Fellow, Sports Sciences Resident, or Member of the RCCSS(C)
- The recipient must submit semi-annual progress reports (at 6 months and 12 months from the commencement of the study) to the “**FOUNDATION**” using the standardized PROGRESS report form
- Upon study completion, the recipient must submit the standardized FINAL report form
- The recipient must acknowledge the “**FOUNDATION for the Royal College of Chiropractic Sports Sciences (Canada)**” as a funding source in any presentation or publication of the awarded work (in the acknowledgement and declaration of funding sources sections)
- The recipient must create an e-presentation for use on the Foundation’s website at the completion of the project
- Funds are forwarded to the applicant only after the recipient forwards proof of study commencement, and grant recipients will have two (2) years from the grant presentation date to provide proof of study commencement in order to receive the allotted funds
